HOW-TO: make a spiderweb mobile

Ingredients:

- Cricut Expression
- Gypsy
- Pumpkin Carvings cartridge
- black card stock
- Tattered Angels Glitter Mist in "Snow Queen"



Step 1

On the Gypsy, arrange one spider web (5-1/4") and five spiders (2-1/4") on a 12x12" mat. Cut out this arrangement on black card stock. Remove the circle from the spider. Tie 6 inch lengths of "Silky" (transparent) thread through the "hourglass" shape in the spider's belly.



Step 2

Spray web with "Snow queen" Glimmer Mist. It is a golden color, but any Glimmer Mist will do.



HOW-TO: make a spiderweb mobile

Step 3

String Silky thread across the paper web. Tie in the middle of opposing outer arcs...it will be important later to ba able to slide the tread on this arc to balance the mobile. Tie another thread to that and tape it up to an armature so you can work.



Step 4

Attach your first spider to the far edge~if you tie it loose enough then you can slide it across the "web" to help balance as you work.



Step 5

Attache all five keeping in mind you have to achieve total balance. Slide the pieces around in order to get this effect.
